



U11 CHAMPIONS CUP GAME RULES AND SYSTEM



THE TOURNAMENT

8 teams will compete in two groups of four. The top two teams in each group will play in a play-off series. The teams then play in the play-off series depending on their group ranking. **GAME TIME:**

2x20 minutes. Running time will be only interrupted for injuries. After each game period there is a **break of 5 minutes**. In each game period there is a possibility for **one time out call**. Each 20-minute period is considered a **separate game**. Penalty shootout after a tie: One-onone penalty shots will follow, any player my shoot multiple times, except for the penalized player. The visiting team always shoots first. Slap shots are permitted.

Body check's only bevor playing the puck.

AGE RESTRICTION: born 2015 – (girls and goalie one year over age 2014)

SYSTEM: 5 – on – 5, large full field

PLAYOFF SYSTEM: 4 – on – 4, large full field, 3 times 10 minutes with a 1-minute break in

between periods, (time runs through, interruption only in case of injuries)

MINIMUM NUMBERS OF PLAYERS: 11+1

SCOURING SYSTEM:

Win in regular time: 3 points
Win after shootout: 2 points
loss after shootout: 1 point
loss in regular time: 0 points

- (a maximum of 3 points can be earned per game.)

- Warm up 2 minutes without pucks – one player can warm up the goalie with a puck **PENALTIES:**

Minor penalty: 2 minutes
Major penalty: 5 minutes
Misconduct penalty: 10 minutes

Any player or team official receiving a Match Penalty during a game is not eligible to participate in the next game of the tournament – replacement is decided be the tournament organization.

JERSEY: Teams will agree among themselves on witch jersey each team will wear.

RULES: IIHF rules are applied; line changes are allowed after icing.

REFEREES: All games are officiated by licensed game officials.

RANKING ORDER:

- 1. Points
- 2. Head to head result: (in case of equal points)
- 3. Head to head goal difference
- 4. Overall goal difference
- 5. More goals scored
- 6. Draw (lottery)
